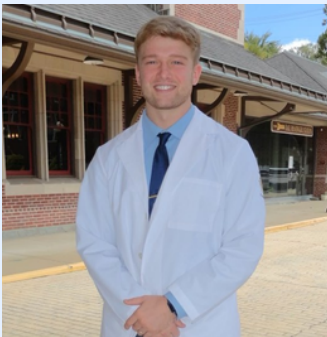
Class Officer VP1 - Matt Smith
